



Parliamentary Standing Committee on Energy Missed a Great Opportunity to Address the NPA Crisis

The report, titled *A Missed Opportunity: A Critique of 'Stressed/Non-Performing Assets in Electricity Sector'* by the Parliamentary Standing Committee on Energy (March-2018), released earlier this week by the Center for Financial Accountability, New Delhi, argued that while the Committee identified a range of reasons for the growing NPAs — from shortage of fuel supply to lack of sufficient Power Purchase Agreements (PPA) by states to delay in implementation of projects resulting in cost overrun — the Committee fell short of providing any concrete solutions to redress the NPA crisis in the power sector. The CFA's critique emphasised that most of the Committee's recommendations were vague. [Read more...](#)
